Returns

If an Amber puff of smoke is showing on your truck dash Diesel Particulate Filter System

If an amber puff of smoke shows up on your dash, please follow the procedure below:

1. Park the vehicle in a safe place
2. Firmly apply the parking brake and put the truck into park position.
3. Turn off the air conditioning if it is in use.
4. Press the DPF cleaning switch to the left bottom side of the steering wheel until the puff of smoke indicator lamp stops flashing and stays lit.
5. The parked DPF regeneration will start.
6. DPF regenerations will normally be completed in about 20 minutes and the puff of smoke indicator lamp will go out indicating that the process has ended.

Thank you for your patience, these systems are installed into the trucks to help with carbon emissions.
